Reading in school and at home



At School

- We will listen to your child read their decodable reading book at least once a week in class and record this in their reading diary.
- Reading is also part of the daily phonics lesson.
- Books will be changed once a week on a Friday.

At Home

- Please listen to your child read their decodable reading book at least 4x week and record in their reading diary.
- Your child will bring home a sharing story from the class library which is a book for an adult to read to the child.

Home/School Link Book

Each week on Friday a home/school link book will be sent home containing a newsletter telling you what your child has been learning in class this week and an activity to complete at home to support the learning in class.

Please bring the home/school link books in on a Wednesday so that I have time to put the week's newsletter etc. in ready to give out on Fridays.

Please use this book to tell us about any achievements your child makes outside of school such as learning to ride a bike or attending swimming classes.

Assessment – formative and summative

Assessment in class:

- Children are assessed through play
- Phonics assessments every 5 weeks

A baseline assessment of each child is completed at the start of the reception year

At the end of the reception year I will complete an early years profile for each child in the class and this will be shared with you in the report each child receives in the Summer term.
