Spelling

Spellings Over the next half term, we will be teaching and practicing Year 3 spelling patterns, but also spelling patterns that need to be imbedded from last year. In Red are the Y2 spelling pattern. In black are the Y3. I suggest the children practice both sets of spellings. If your child finds the Y3 spellings hard to recall, focus on the Year 2 patterns. Some children will have focused spellings that will be added to their homework log.

Examples of spelling pattern: adverbs where the root word ends 'le' (gentle- gently)
