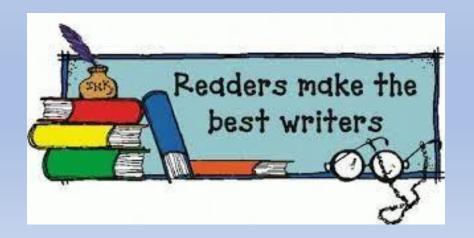

### This is from Adams site:

The Test comprises two papers, which assess English
Comprehension, Verbal Reasoning, Non-Verbal Reasoning and
Numerical Reasoning provided by GL Assessments. Normally,
each test paper is approx. 50 minutes in length. School
administration for each test will normally be 1 hour. All questions
are multiple choice and contained in a question booklet.
Candidates MUST write answers on the separate answer sheets
provided.

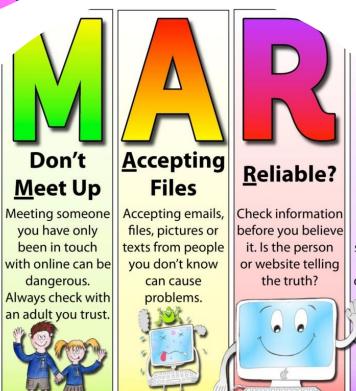
