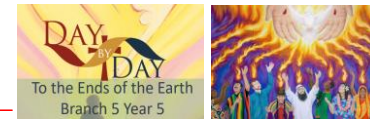
2. How do compare and contrast Ancient Greek religion with Ancient Roman religion? **To build an overview of world history.** Use sources of evidence to deduce information about the past
